

CMKC Easter Grand Draw 2021

Terms and Conditions

The Camphill MK Easter Grand Draw 2021 is run by and in benefit of Camphill Milton Keynes Communities Limited, which is a Registered Charity (283556) and Company Limited by Guarantee, under a Small Society Lottery licence issued by Milton Keynes Council.

Ethan Hopkinson, Camphill MK Communities, Japonica Lane, Willen Park South, Milton Keynes, MK15 9JY is the person responsible for the draw.

Entering the Draw

Each entry will cost £1 and the maximum number of entries that an individual can purchase is 100. Tickets should not be sold to or by anyone under the age of sixteen. Purchasing tickets on behalf of someone under the age of sixteen is also not allowed and the named responsible person is ineligible to enter the draw.

Tickets shall be purchased through donorbox.org/cmkc-easter-grand-draw and in accordance with guidance from the Gambling Commission credit card payments will not be allowed – any payments made by Credit Card will be refunded and returned.

Payments received through other mediums, including but not limited to, CAF payments, cheque payments, cash payments and card donations through other systems cannot be accepted as entries into the draw and will be viewed as a donation.

With the exception of ineligible entries (credit card payments, entries by or for someone under sixteen and those with a gambling exclusion) no refunds will be given and if you choose to remove your tickets from the draw your payment will be treated as a donation.

Camphill Milton Keynes Communities takes no responsibility for any technical failures or issues that result in issues with payment being taken or tickets being sent.

The entry portal will be closed once ticket sales have ended however if, for whatever reason, payment is accepted the charity accepts no responsibility for payments made in error and the payment will be treated as a donation.

Gift Aid cannot be claimed on raffle ticket entries.



Camphill Milton Keynes Communities Limited reserves the right to disqualify any entry for any reason at their absolute discretion.

The Raffle Draw

No more entries will be allowed into the draw after 17.00 pm on Wednesday 31st March 2021. At 09.00 am on Thursday 1st April the valid entries will be loaded into <https://wheelofnames.com/> and the draw will commence. A video of the draw will be taken for verification purposes and will be available in an unedited format upon request from the local authority or any draw entrant.

The first five names drawn have an allocated prize as shown below:

- Prize 2: Lindt Hamper
- Prize 3: Cadbury Bundle
- Prize 4: Milton-Keynesia Peace Pagoda Decoration
- Prize 5: Milton-Keynesia Campbell Park Sunrise Tote Bag

Other names drawn will be able to pick their prize from the remaining prize pool in order of when their ticket is drawn. For example winner number 6 will choose first, then winner number seven and so on.

The result of the raffle is final, and no correspondence will be entered into. Winners will be notified on the same day and should arrange a date to collect their prizes from Camphill MK Communities. Prizes can be posted upon request at the expense of the winner and the winner can nominate someone else to collect their prize and should notify the charity of this by email from the email address associated with the entry.

A list of winners will be published on our website using their first name only.

Camphill Milton Keynes Communities will make every attempt to contact the winner and will hold prizes for six weeks or until the next raffle opens. If the winner has not made contact by the deadline (six weeks or next raffle, whichever is sooner) then the unclaimed prize can be used in the way the charity sees fit including being used as a prize for a future raffle.

The charity takes no responsibility for the condition of any prizes and complaints or queries should be raised directly with the supplier of the prize.

Responsible Gambling



Any supporter can request to be excluded from raffles and other activities that constitute gambling. This exclusion will prevent a supporter from receiving promotional material about gambling activities and will prevent them from entering gambling activities.

If software doesn't allow for the prevention of sales, the entry will be rejected, and entry fee returned as soon as possible.
